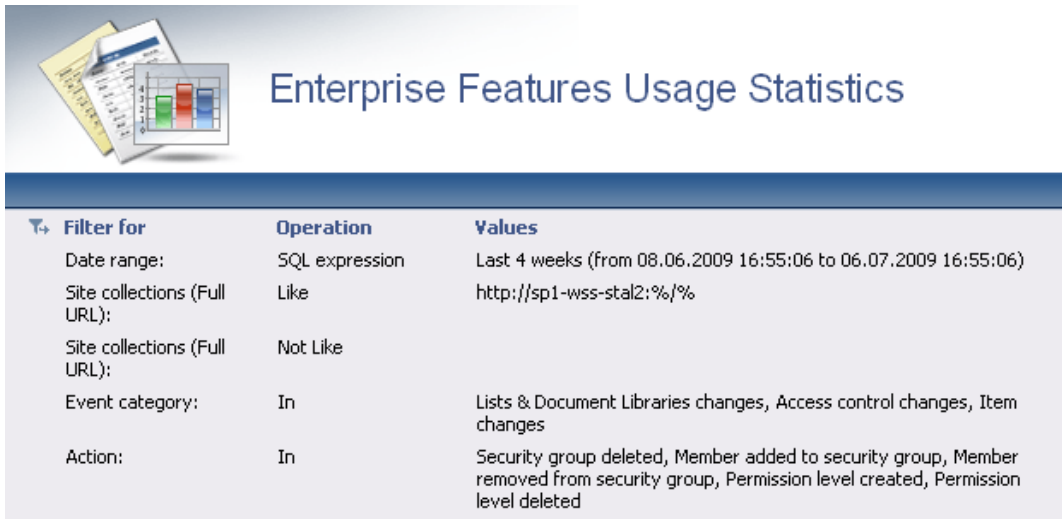
# What's New in Site Administrator for Share Point—Security Auditor 1.3

Security Auditor adds two new reports that allow customers to stay in compliance with Microsoft Office SharePoint Server (MOSS) 2007 licensing and keep an audit trail of changes to Site Collection administrators.

## Enterprise Features Usage

Companies often leverage MOSS Enterprise features (such as Business Data Catalog, Excel Calculation Services, and InfoPath Forms service integration) only for specific sites and a particular subset of users. Enterprise Client Access Licenses (CALs) can be purchased for the users who need access to these sites, but tracking usage is difficult, and companies risk becoming non-compliant with the licensing terms.

Security Auditor's new Enterprise Features Usage report provides the information required to track MOSS feature use and ensure MOSS license compliance. Specifically, you can track the number of unique users who have accessed sites that leverage MOSS Enterprise features within specified date ranges, and drill down to see who these users are.

# Site Collection Ownership

Security Auditor's set of security change reports has been expanded with the new Site Collection Ownership report, which provides an audit trail of modifications to the Site Collection Administrators setting in SharePoint Central Administration. This setting is available to farm administrators and can be used to grant administrative access to all data in a site collection. The Site Collection Ownership report shows all users who granted or revoked Site Collection Administrator privileges.

This Quest Site Administrator for SharePoint - Security Auditor report shows SharePoint users and groups that were granted or revoked particular permission levels to SharePoint site collections.
